Reception Nativity Performances

As Christmas is fast approaching, we would like to take this opportunity to invite you to your child's Nativity Performance which will take place on <u>Wednesday 13th December</u>. We have space in the school hall to accommodate **two tickets per family**. As the children have worked very hard to put on this performance for you, we politely request that, if younger siblings are attending, they are able to sit quietly for the duration of the performance.

Each class will perform their Nativity Story at the following times:

Rec L Angelfish Class - 9.30 -10.10 am Rec DE Turtle Class - 10.45 - 11.25 am Rec T Starfish Class - 1.50 - 2.30 pm

The School Office doors will open for admittance 15 minutes before each performance time. During the performance, we will be insisting on a 'no screens' policy please. Not all of the children in Reception have permissions to be photographed or videoed and it is far more important for the children to see your smiling faces. We politely ask you to respect this. The dress rehearsal of each class's Nativity will be recorded and the recordings made available for you to download during the Christmas Holidays so look out for the e-mail containing the link. Please respect others' privacy by not posting the videos or portions thereof on social media. Those children without full image permissions will not be included in the filming.

At the end of the morning performances, you will be signed out of the school building via the School Office. However, at the end of the afternoon performance by Reception T (Starfish Class), you will be able to collect your child early, if you would like to, once they have returned to their classroom and got changed. If your child has older siblings **at the Infant School** then you will also be able to collect them early from school.
