ACCEPTED WASTE



Please remove as much toothpaste from the tube as possible.

Waste that is NOT accepted:

- Any toothbrushes not made from plastic
- Reusable toothbrush handles
- Interdental brushes
- Battery operated toothbrushes
- Dental floss (string)
- Mouthwash plastic bottles
- Breath sprays
- Denture adhesives packaging
- Denture tablets packaging
- Denture cream tubes
- Outer packaging that did not contain toothbrushes or dental floss
- Cartons that did not contain toothpaste
- Tubes that did not contain toothpaste
- Toothpaste pumps
- Toothache kits

Pens, felt tips, highlighters, markers




Mechanical pencils and correction instruments (tape and fluid pots), fountain pens, ink cartridges



THE CONFECTIONERY RECYCLING PROGRAMME

ACCEPTED WASTE

All brands of plastic confectionery packaging are accepted in the programme, examples of which can be seen below.

Plastic chocolate and sweets pouches and bags

Waste that is NOT accepted

- Breakfast, granola and energy bar wrappers
- Aluminium foil, cardboard and paper wrappers. For example: individual foil and paper packets (like ROWNTREE'S® Fruit Pastilles or KITKAT® Biscuits) and cardboard tubes and boxes (like SMARTIES® or AFTER EIGHT®) are not accepted in this programme. These can be recycled via local council facilities.
- Metal tins and rigid plastic trays or tubs. For example: QUALITY STREET® plastic tubs or DAIRY BOX® chocolate box packaging are not accepted in this programme. These can be recycled via local council facilities.
- QUALITY STREET® wrappers as these are biodegradable via home composting.



PERSONAL CARE AND BEAUTY RECYCLING PROGRAMME

ACCEPTED WASTE

All brands are accepted!

Flexible single use mask packaging and the blue plastic film put on top of the tissue mask (used for personal care and beauty products)



Flexible plastic wipes packaging (used for personal care and beauty products)



Personal care and beauty product packaging caps, pumps and trigger sprays (rigid plastic bottles are not accepted)



Plastic pots and flexible plastic tubes (used for personal care and beauty products)



Hair colourant kits (except rigid plastic bottles and cardboard packaging)



Plastic roll-on deodorants (aerosols are not accepted)



Personal Care and Beauty Programme

WASTE THAT IS NOT ACCEPTED

- Rigid plastic bottles (used for shampoo, conditioner, hair serum, hair colouring, skin care, sun protection and body care packaging)
- Plastic pots and flexible plastic tubes not used for personal care and beauty products (such as food pots and tubes, grout tubes and glue tubes)
- Cardboard packaging
- Aerosols
- Flexible plastic wipes packaging not used for personal care and beauty products (such as surface cleaning wipes packaging ; baby wipes packaging ; window wipes packaging)

THE RB® HYGIENE HOME RECYCLING PROGRAMME

ACCEPTED WASTE



Waste that is NOT accepted:

- Laundry detergent packaging
- Toilet freshener packaging
- Aerosols
- Plastic bottles and tubs
- Dishwasher liquid bottles, rinse aid packaging
- Fragrance candles, reeds, plug ins and autosprays
- Soda crystals packaging
- Washing machine and oven cleaner packaging
- Cardboard

Please note that most of the items listed above (plastic bottles, paper, cardboard, aerosols and glass) can be recycled via your local council facilities.
