



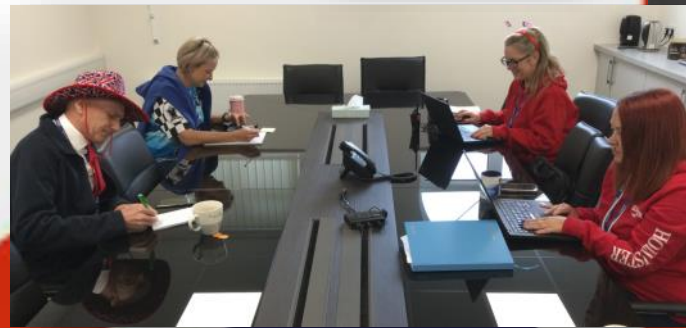

SOLENT INFANT SCHOOL



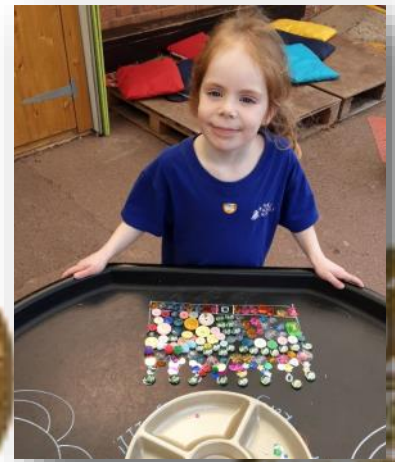
