Fraser Portraits will then print and pack your orders, returning them to you via school. If you should have any queries please contact Fraser Portraits direct. These class photographs will be available for other parents to order.

If you do not wish your child to be in the whole class photograph, please email the relevant school office solentinfant@thesolentschools.org or solentjunior@thesolentschools.org to notify us no later than 6pm on Thursday 8th June. If your child is in school on the day, and for safeguarding reasons you do not want them included in the whole class photograph that is distributed, there is the option for them to be photographed separately and inserted into the class photo.
