Early collection from the Infant School will be from your child's usual year group door (except for 1C who will be collected from the main Year 1 door, where they are dropped off in the morning).

If your child has an older sibling at Solent Junior School, please read the important note below.

Before collecting your infant school child, please come to the junior school office at the following times:

For children who have a Year R sibling, please collect your child from the Junior School at 1:50pm For children who have a Year 1 sibling, please collect your child from the Junior School at 2:05pm For children who have a Year 2 sibling, please collect your child from the Junior School at 2:20pm

We hope this is all clear, we look forward to seeing you all at the Carols tomorrow at 5.30pm (gates open at 5.00pm for mince pies, hot dogs, hot chocolate and mulled wine!) and the Christmas Fayre on Friday, both being held at Solent Infant School.
