My Favourite Things: *Places*

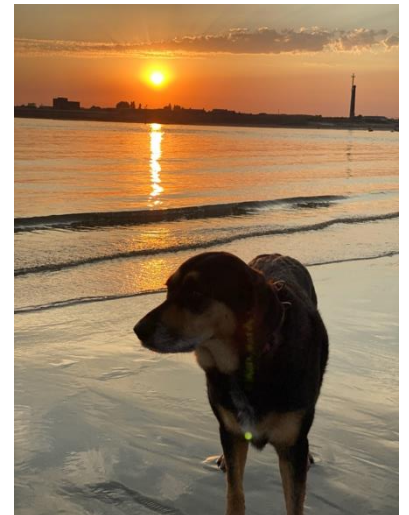

Solent Junior School:

We would like Junior school pupils to write the opening of a fiction story which features your favourite place. It could be your own home, where you walk, somewhere you have visited or even somewhere you have been on holiday. Your story opening should be no more than 200 words and make Governors want to read more.

Solent Infant School:

Infant school pupils have a choice of writing the opening to a fiction story, drawing a picture of their favourite place and writing down, or have an adult write down, your reasons for why it is so special. Once again it could be your home, garden, local park or somewhere further afield you have visited or which holds special memories for you.
